 - 10. Encourage faithfully


All of which sounds like my last 10 sermons.

Loving radically involves stepping out of your comfort zone, seeing people the way Jesus sees them, as children of God; not as a drain on society, but someone who can add to our huge melting pot of humanity. The United States wouldn't exist without immigration and we need the rejuvenation "outsiders" can bring.

Inviting others to church should be job number two (number one should be bringing your family to church, so they too can learn to me some of yours. I promise to return the fapass on their faith). The best evangelist I knew was a third-grader who kept inviting her friends to Sunday School. Several of them ended up bringing their families, who eventually joined the church.

Your church is a volunteer organization. A pastor, an organist and a pianist, a part-time secretary and a part-time custodian are the only paid staff for the parish. We have many who volunteer joyfully; we just need more of them. In every church in which I've been a member, 20% do 80% of the work. Come and share the load. It will be worth your time and talent, because I quarantee you will receive more than you give.

Sharing Jesus with others, including family and friends, should be like breathing. You have been given the greatest gift of all time! If you love them, pass it on!

In this day and age of the internet, we, as a society, are increasingly connected, yet more and more isolated. Humans are social creatures designed to interact with each

other. Electronic communication won't give you the same bond you make talking to people live, face-to-face. Make fellowship part of your daily routine, but especially on Sunday mornings.

Sunday might be your one day to sleep in and God did tell us to rest on the 7th day, but God also made it very clear that Sunday was to be reserved for worship. Enthusiasm can be contagious. When I don't have any, give vor when your fervor is waning.

We have been commanded to pray for one another. Grab the prayer list and start there. But as you pray don't forget to take time to listen for what God is asking you to do. Prayer isn't meant to be just a wish list. It's intended to be a two-way street, with communication going both directions.

And finally, be faithful and encourage others to do the same. When you see someone down, help them up. When you see someone sad, lift them up. When you see someone experiencing pain you've already endured, use your experience to help them through. And when you see someone happy, celebrate their triumphs. Your Lord wants all of us to experience joy. Do your part to make that possible.

You also might tape the list to your bathroom mirror as a reminder, morning and evening, of whose you are.
