"Singin' in the Rain!"


What is April's favorite song?

Discussed having a 'Move Up' Sunday on the last Sunday of each month in order to get the congregation to move up enough to be seen on live online services. Incentives were discussed.


Renew Thrift Store sustained water damage to some floor tiles. Discussion was made as to its repair. Pam requested tile replacement for the area where the tiles are missing.

Report Highlights:
